On Tuesday, students from Years 3-6 competed in the Pinewood House Athletics Carnival, at Bill Sewart Athletics Track in Burwood East.

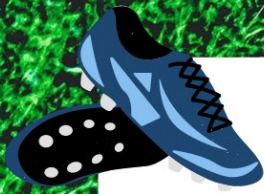

We will be encouraging students to use Matific at school and home during this week to engage them in the Maths Olympiad.



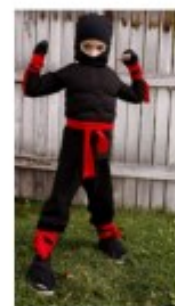

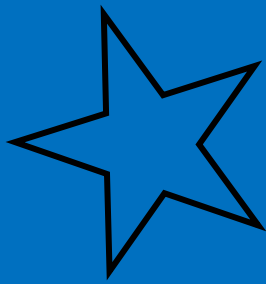

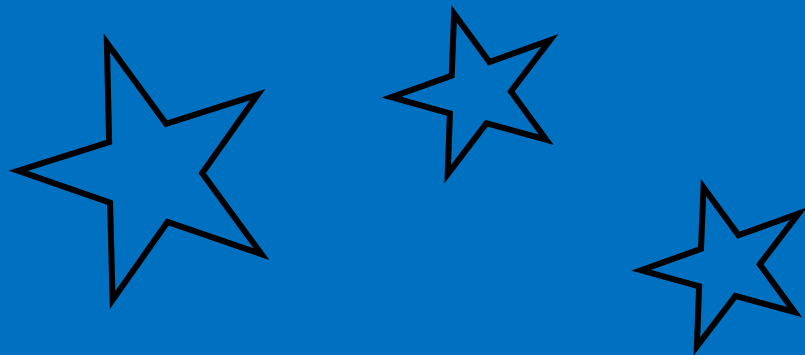


Celebrating the Olympic Games Through Artwork

Congratulations to all featured artists this week.

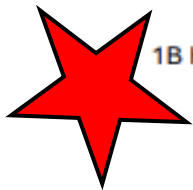
