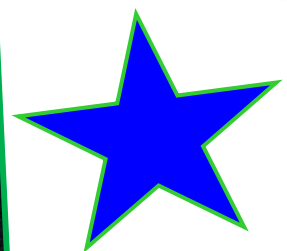
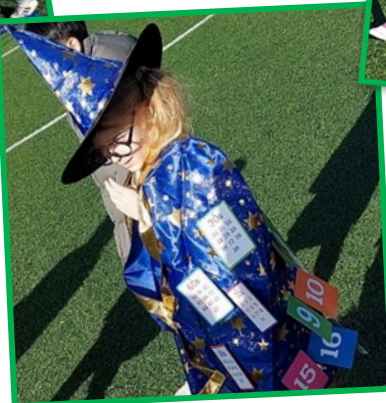
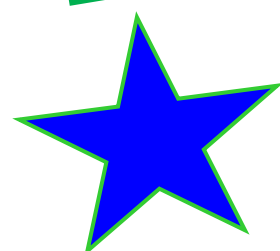
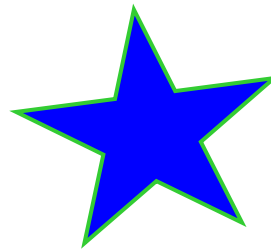
PREPS LEARN FIRST AID

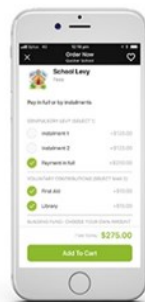
