#### **Right to Disconnect**

As you would be aware, recent amendments to the Fair Work Legislation came into effect recently. The Department of Education provided its response to this noting the rights of all staff to disconnect. These new provisions will be adopted alongside the department's existing industrial and employment obligations, including occupational health and safety commitments.

The legislation makes it explicit that all employees have the right to refuse contact from their employer or a third party (such as a parent or families) outside of their normal working hours unless that refusal is unreasonable. This means an employee can refuse to monitor, read or respond to contact that occurs outside their normal working hours. I would appreciate your support and understanding when communicating with staff in recognising and respecting their right to work-life balance.


